Household Supplies:

- ◆ Toilet paper
- ◆ Paper towels
- ◆ Bath and facial soap
- ◆ Liquid disinfectants (like Pine Sol/Lysol)
- ◆ Laundry detergent
- ◆ Kitchen garbage bags (13-gallon size)
- ◆ Large garbage bags (33-gallon size)
- ◆ Size 4 & 5 diapers
- ◆ Lightbulbs (60w & 100w)

Secondary needs:

- ◆ Toilet-bowl cleaner
- ◆ Window cleaner (like Windex)
- ◆ Liquid bleach
- ◆ Powdered cleanser (e.g., Comet)
- ◆ Sponges
- ◆ Scrubbing pads
- ◆ Dish towels
- ◆ Fabric softener (liquid or dryer sheets)
- ◆ Dish soap (*not* dishwasher detergent)
- ◆ Baby wipes
- ◆ Furniture polish/cleaner (like Pledge or Endust)
- ◆ Wal-Mart/Target gift cards

Food Items:

- ◆ Cooking Oil (preferably olive, canola, or vegetable)
- ◆ White Rice
- ◆ Canned/bottled nonrefrigerated juice
- ◆ Canned Fruit
- ◆ Canned Tomatoes
- ◆ Crackers (e.g., saltines, Ritz crackers)
- ◆ After-school snacks (low-sodium, nonperishable snacks suitable for children)

About Interfaith Outreach Home IOH provides transitional housing for families experiencing an episode of homelessness. Families in the IOH program live in self-contained apartments at IOH's Doraville facility and take part in intensive counseling and life-skills training. The IOH program helps families regain their self-sufficiency within nine to twelve months and maintain their independence when they complete the program.
